A few months ago I was in a meeting where we honored Bob Buford. If you don't know his story you should read the book "Half-Time." Bob had reached all of the life-goals he had set for himself by his early 40's. He was running a successful cable TV company, had a happy marriage, a beautiful home, and a lot of toys.

Here's the problem: although Wall Street standards labeled his life a success, he felt something was lacking. He started asking questions like, "Am I really making a difference in the world?" "What will be the legacy of my life?" With the partner agreement signed and the Highway Occupancy Permit issued, construction of the new access road (Discovery Drive) is slated to begin May 18. Completion of the road is expected by the end of Sept or early Oct. Meanwhile Bob Cameron and our civil engineering firm are moving ahead with finalizing a septic plan for DEP approval. We're optimistic that it will be well received but, as always, please continue to pray for this important piece. The task force assigned to conduct a community needs assessment met this past Tuesday for a productive session of identifying key people and organizations from which we will seek feedback. Pray also for this group as they attempt to complete this process in a relatively short timeframe over the next 2-3 weeks.

100X HEART

Above all else guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life. Proverbs 4:23 (NIV)

But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop. Luke 8:15 (NIV)

At the heart of a life without walls

is a heart without walls.

PRESS PAUSE: WHAT IS THE CAPACITY OF MY HEART?

One day Jesus told a story in the form of a parable to a large crowd that had gathered from many towns to hear him: A farmer went out to plant his seed. As he scattered it across his field, some seed fell on a footpath, where it was stepped on, and the birds ate it. Other seed fell among rocks. It began to grow, but the plant soon wilted and died for lack of moisture. Other seed fell among thorns that grew up with it and choked out the tender plants. Still other seed fell on fertile soil. This seed grew and produced a crop that was a hundred times as much as had been planted! When he had said this, he called out, Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand. Luke 8:4-8 (NLT)

WHAT IS THE TEXTURE OF A 100X HEART?

This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is God's word. The seeds that fell on the footpath represent those who hear the message, only to have the devil come and take it away from their hearts and prevent them from believing and being saved.

Luke 8:11-12 (NLT)

IT IS A SOFT HEART.

The seeds on the rocky soil represent those who hear the message and receive it with joy. But since they don't have deep roots, they believe for a while, then they fall away when they face temptation. Luke 8:13 (NLT)

IT IS A DEEP HEART

The seeds that fell among the thorns represent those who hear the message, but all too quickly the message is crowded out by the cares and riches and pleasures of this life. And so they never grow into maturity. Luke 8:14 (NLT)

IT IS A PURE HEART
